Camping Rules

Gate Code: _____

- 1) Camper's stay is limited to 3 days, unless approved by the Park Ranger.
- 2) Park hours are from 8:00 a.m. until sunset. Campers' guests must vacate the park prior to sunset. Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- 3) Maximum number of campers per site:
 - a) Hickory Flats 6 per site or 48 for a group
 - b) Magnolia Hill 6 per site or 42 for a group
 - c) Squirrel Run 8 per seven cabins, 6 per two cabins or 52 for a group
 - d) Big Pine Shores 16 per cabin or 32 for a group
 - e) Treehouse Point 4 per tree house or 36 for a group
 - f) Ahwenassa 4 per cabin or 36 for a group
 - g) Muscogee 4 per cabin
 - h) Cook's Cabin 4 per cabin
- 4) **Pets cannot stay overnight or be in any buildings;** must be kept on a leash at ALL times; never left unattended; have proof of rabies immunization on the animal's collar; and cleaned up after.
- 5) **No Alcoholic Beverages** allowed! (*Clay County Code, Chapter 3, Article I, Ordinance 79-15, as amended by Ordinance 91-54*).
- 6) **No Smoking** allowed in cabins or buildings! (*Fla. Statute 386, Fla. Clean Indoor Act*)
- 7) **No Graffiti** or defacing Park buildings or property.
- 8) Glass bottles or glass containers are not allowed on Park property.
- 9) Trees and branches may not be cut down for any reason.
- 10) No cash refunds! Refunds may take up to 45 days to process.
- 11) Not Permitted: extension cords, portable AC units, electric heaters, TV's, etc.
- 12) Fishing permitted only on the Jungle Trail Pier or from the bulkhead on Black Creek.
- 13) Swimming or fishing in Otter Springs (pond) is not permitted.
- 14) Wildlife and plant life (including flowers) are protected – DO NOT DISTURB!
- 15) No motorized or battery operated vehicles are allowed beyond the designated parking areas, i.e. golf carts, scooters, four wheelers, etc.
- 16) Campfires are permitted only within the fire rings. Extinguish all fires in fire rings and fireplaces. Please be conservative with the firewood that is provided.
- 17) Keep campsite free of rubbish and flammable materials.
- 18) Grills are for cooking with charcoal only – DO NOT USE FIREWOOD.

It is the camper's responsibility to provide their registered guests with the rules and gate combination.

Staff is not available to open the gate after hours.
