## Camp Chowenwaw Park

### What is there TO DO and TO SEE?

#### Trails:



**T**he Jungle Trail is a boardwalk that leads to Black Creek.

**A** one mile Hiking Trail winds through the woods.

**B**ike or walk the Black Creek Trail. It is a paved trail that runs almost the entire length of Fleming Island.

#### Wildlife:

**W**arm spring-time water temperatures attract Manatee to the St. John's River and Black Creek.



**A**n active Bald Eagle's nest can be seen from the fishing pier.

**M**any deer are seen feeding in the quietness of the morning.



#### Fishing:

**F**ishing sites for campers and visitors are on the Jungle Trail and bulkhead.



#### Boating:

**K**night's Boat Ramp and Marina are directly across Highway 17. Bait is for sale in the adjoining shop.



**A** carry-in canoe and kayak launch is on Black Creek.

#### Picnicking and Camp Fires:

**C**ampers can enjoy indoor fireplaces and outside fire rings.



**V**isitors and campers may utilize outside grills, picnic tables, and pavilions.

#### Environmental Education Classes and Nature Walks:

**C**lasses and Nature Walks can be scheduled year-round for schools and community groups.



#### History and Girl Scout Museum\*:

**C**amp Chowenwaw ("Camp of the Little Sisters") was operated as a Girl Scout camp from 1932 until 2006 (\*Museum is under development.)



**T**he Big Cabin was built by the Civilian Conservation Corp during the Great Depression.

#### Play Area:

**Y**oung children can have some exercise and fun at the playground. A game of volleyball can be enjoyed on the sand court near the pool.



#### Swimming Pool:

The pool is open to the public from Memorial Day to Labor Day.



#### Otter Springs:

**T**he "Old Pond" (the original Girl Scout swimming hole) has an observation dock with interpretive signs of native fish and plants.
