This board has been asked to assist with the Early Florida Village during the Clay Co. Fair in April. The date is the Sunday, April 6, 2014.

This board will plan and finalize the activities for Saturday, May 3, 2014, for Clay County Historical Preservation Day at the March and April meetings.

Marilyn Haddock provided members with a current listing of Clay County historical markers. She also invited members to participate in any of the activities planned for March, Clay Co. History Month.
